Emergency Response Plan

Post-Accident Tracking:

A voice recording system with a time stamp will be installed to monitor the mine phone system. In the event of an accident, it will be able to be played back to determine the immediate pre-accident location of all underground personnel. Upon plan approval, this system will be ordered and installed in a timely manner.

Post-Accident Breathable Air:

In addition to the two SCSRs per miner required by the Emergency Temporary Standard, SCSR's will be stored in both escapeways from the working sections to the bottom at a distance no further than an average miner can walk in 30 minutes. A test conducted in the primary escapeway with a 54 year old miner showed that distance to be 8,000 feet.

SCSRs will be maintained, examined, stored, and retired according to the manufacturer's recommendations. On an annual basis, 1% of the SCSRs will be sent to the manufacturer for reliability testing. If possible, units at the end of their service life will be used for this purpose. Post-Accident Lifelines:

Directional lifelines, or their equivalent, will be used in the escapeways to enable evacuation. As the sections advance, the lifelines will be advanced in a timely manner.

Post-Accident Communication:

A secondary phone system will be installed from each working section to the surface. It will be installed in an entry separate from the existing phone system that is in the alternate escapeway. Upon plan approval, the necessary components will be ordered. After receipt of the components, the system should be installed within 90 days. As the section advances, the secondary phone system will be advanced in a timely manner.

• Training:

The training for evacuation procedures will be conducted quarterly and is outlined in our previously approved 30 CFR 75.1502 Mine Emergency Evacuation and Fire Fighting Plan Supplement dated April 7, 2006.

The hands on SCSR training, including transferring, is covered in our previously approved Part 48 Training Plan Supplement submitted on April 6, 2006.

To provide for the maintenance of miners trapped underground, the following will be maintained within five (5) crosscuts of the section belt tail:

For barricading purposes: The equivalent of four (4) brattice boards equal to the entry width, brattice cloth, sealant material, eight roof jacks or props, spads, trowel and protective gloves, two claw hammers and nails, and 240 pounds of rock dust;

Inflatable shelters or equivalent may be used in lieu of barricading materials or other quick deployable units;

Food and potable water sufficient for a sustained period of time;

and First Aid kits, blankets, multi-gas detector (from Foreman), and chemical light-sticks or other effective permissible light sources.

Post-Accident Logistics:

A guard will be placed at the mine entrance for traffic control;

The command center will be set up in the mine's training room and have access to both public and mine phones;

Press will not be allowed past the guard at the mine entrance;

The Boston Chapel Christian Church, 19051 Boston Chapel Road, Girard, Illinois 62640, will be utilized to accommodate families. A guard will be posted at the entrance to the church.
