- LQD was directed by the Joint Committee on Minerals, Business and Economic Development to conduct a feasibility study in the spring 2022.
- The final study report was completed and provided to the Minerals Committee September 26, 2022.
- Draft legislation was sent to the NRC on December 22, 2022.
- NRC review was completed (no comments) on January 4, 2023.





- ▶ HB0061 passed, amending Article 20 of the Environmental Quality Act.
- Added authority to pursue an agreement to regulate
  - "...source material recovered from any mineral resources processed primarily for purposes other than obtaining the source material content. For the purposes of this agreement, the term "mineral resources" means any host rock, ore, material or waste associated with mining or milling that contains a recoverable mineral."





- Statute language was developed to be separate from existing URP language.
- ▶ HB0061 provided funding for 2 additional FTE and 50% of the URP manager's time to set up the program in 4 years.
  - Funding started April 1, 2023



#### **Source Material Program Staffing**



- Program Manager
  - 50% time during standup, 10% after standup
- 2 SMP Technical Employees
  - Health Physicists (ENNR11)
- 1 FTE LQD Staff
  - After standup.





- New SMP will be created
  - Separate set of rules from URP
  - Separate Guidance from URP
  - Expanded Training Requirements
    - Will meet URP training, but with additional requirements
- Will submit an application with the NRC to amend Wyoming's Agreement


