Review Requested: Draft NMA Outlines on EPA's Proposed Repeals of Power Plant Clean Air Act Rules

The National Mining Association (NMA) requests feedback from members on draft comment outlines responding to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) proposals to repeal greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions standards for the power sector under Section 111 of the Clean Air Act (CAA) (now called the Carbon Pollution Standards) and to repeal amendments to the 2024 Mercury and Air Toxics Standards (MATS) under Section 112 of the CAA. Comments on the MATS repeal are due on **Aug. 11, 2025**. Drafts of the comment submissions will be shared in advance for review. The NMA will also share shorter template letters closer to the deadlines for members to use for company submissions.
