SUBJECT: NMA President and CEO to Testify Before House Natural

Resources Committee on Permitting Reform

On Wednesday, September 10, at 10:00 a.m., National Mining Association (NMA) President and CEO Rich Nolan will testify before the House Natural Resources Committee in support of Chairman Bruce Westerman's (R-Ark.) H.R. 4776, the bipartisan "Standardizing Permitting and Expediting Economic Development (SPEED) Act." Please find a link to the hearing here. Additional bills being considered at the hearing include:

- Rep. Rudy Yakym's (R-Ind.) <u>H.R. 573</u>, the "Studying NEPA's Impact on Projects Act,"
- Rep. Dusty Johnson's (R-S.D.) <u>H.R. 4503</u>, the "ePermit Act."

The bipartisan SPEED Act, co-sponsored by Rep. Jared Golden (D-Maine), would streamline the NEPA process by clarifying its procedural scope, focusing agency reviews on impacts closely tied to proposed projects, and allowing state or tribal reviews to meet federal requirements.
